

This programme is a **semestrial intensive training course of 180 hours**, based on French language learning covering all 6 levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFRL), with 20h of complementary workshop.

Open to any person willing to acquire competences in French language, it will make you discover the French language and culture, but also, for intermediate and advanced levels, prepare for French university studies, by combining command of the language and progressive disciplinary immersion.

As a diploma course, the DUEF is offered to students enrolled in the framework of bilateral agreements signed with foreign universities. It enables students to get **30 ECTS credits**.



WHO CAN REGISTER?



Anyone over the age of 18, with or without preliminary knowledge in the French language, who has completed secondary education (high-school diploma).

Added-value of our training course:






- Small-group learning;

The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFRL) includes 6 levels:



- If you have no knowledge of French language at all, you will be automatically registered in the A1 level.
- ▶ If you have already some knowledge of French language and if you have a diploma or certification (DELF-DALF or TCF) to attest your level, you will be registered in the corresponding level (for example, if you have a DELF-B1 certification, you will attend group B2)
- ▶ If you have some knowledge of the French language, but you do not know exactly what your real level is, you will make a level test upon your arrival at the USMB and you will be registered in the corresponding level.

Attention: Level groups will be open, subject to a minimum number of participants.



HOW TO REGISTER?



Fill in our online registration form. After a careful examination of your application, you will receive specific instructions to be officially registered. This registration will be definitely confirmed after payment of the registration fees to the university.



PRICE



Price of the course per semester (valid for the academic year 2022/2023): 1700€

INCLUDED:

- ▶ 180 hours of intensive French language courses; 15 hours per week, from Monday to Friday, from 9 am to 12 pm
- ▶ 2 thematic workshop (10h) of your choice : extra 2 hours, once per week from 1:30 to 3:30 pm (day will be communicated on arrival depending on level)
- ▶ Enrolment for the Test de Connaissance du Français (TCF-Test : oral comprehension and written comprehension)
- ► Access to cultural and sport activities organized by USMB for its international students (most activities are free of charge);
- Access to the different university services: university library and restaurants, preventive medicine, etc.

NOT INCLUDED:

- ▶ Payment of the Contribution Vie Etudiante (92€/year) that allows you to get the student card
- Insurance covering liability (about 16€/year)
- ▶ Accommodation, food and any other personal expenses.
