WHAT IS IT?

This programme is a **semestrial extensive training course of 45 hours**, based on French language learning covering all 6 levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). 39 hours of lessons are provided face-to-face, 6 extra hours will be to be carried out according to modalities to be confirmed at the beginning of the semester (event on an extra day organized, self-study via USMB platforms ect...). Open to any person willing to acquire competences in French language, it will make you discover the French language and culture, but also, for intermediate and advanced levels, prepare for French university studies, by combining command of the language and progressive disciplinary immersion. This course enables students to get **4 ECTS credits**.



WHO CAN TAKE PART?

Anyone over the age of 18, with or without preliminary knowledge in the French language. Secondary school diploma recommended. Course non suitable to publics that would previously need an alphabetization course.

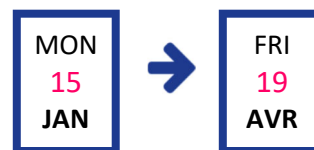
FALL SEMESTER (= semestre 1)

Added-value of our training course:



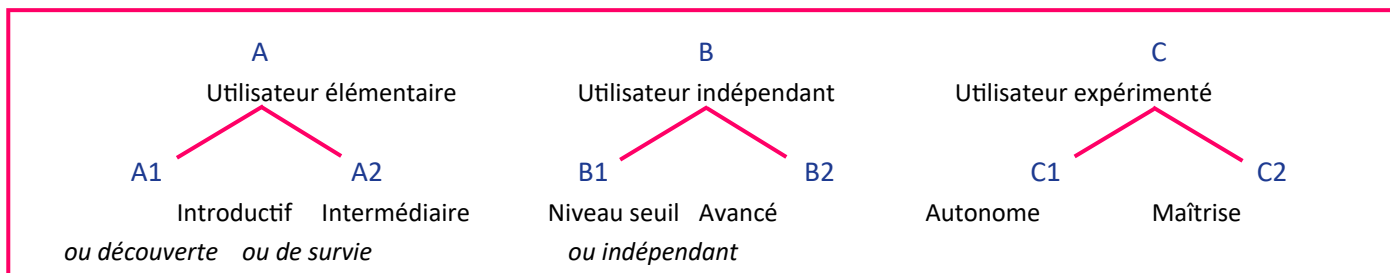
- ▶ **Small-group** learning; Average 16 students per class

HOW DO I KNOW WHICH LEVEL I SHOULD TAKE?



The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) includes 6 levels:



- ▶ If you have no knowledge of French language at all, you will be automatically registered in the A1 level.
- ▶ If you have already some knowledge of French language and if you have a diploma or certification (DELTA-DALF or TCF) to attest your level, you will be registered in the corresponding level (for example, if you have a DELTA-B1 certification, you will attend group B2)
- ▶ If you have some knowledge of the French language, but you do not know exactly what your real level is, you will make a level test upon your arrival at the USMB and you will be registered in the corresponding level.

Attention: Groups will be open, subject to a minimum number of participants.

At the beginning of the course, the teacher will evaluate the participants' level and will confirm the right level group.



HOW TO REGISTER?



Fill in our online registration form. After a careful examination of your application, you will receive specific instructions to be officially registered. This registration will be definitely confirmed after payment of the registration fees to the university.



PRICE



Price of the training course (valid for the academic year 2023/2024):

450 € / session (i.e per semestre)*

INCLUDED:

- ▶ 45 hours of intensive French language training courses;
- ▶ Enrolment for the Test de Connaissance du Français (TCF-Test);
- ▶ Access to cultural and sport activities organized by USMB for its international students
- ▶ Access to the different university services: university library and restaurants, preventive medicine, etc.

NOT INCLUDED:

- ▶ Payment of the Contribution Vie Etudiante (100€/year) - mandatory to get a student card
- ▶ Insurance covering liability (about 16€/year) - mandatory
- ▶ Accommodation, food and any other personal expenses.

- ▶ USMB employed staff & PhD students : **online registration mandatory** via usmb email
- ▶ Students part of an exchange/Erasmus programme : automatically enrolled > a level test will have to be taken
