

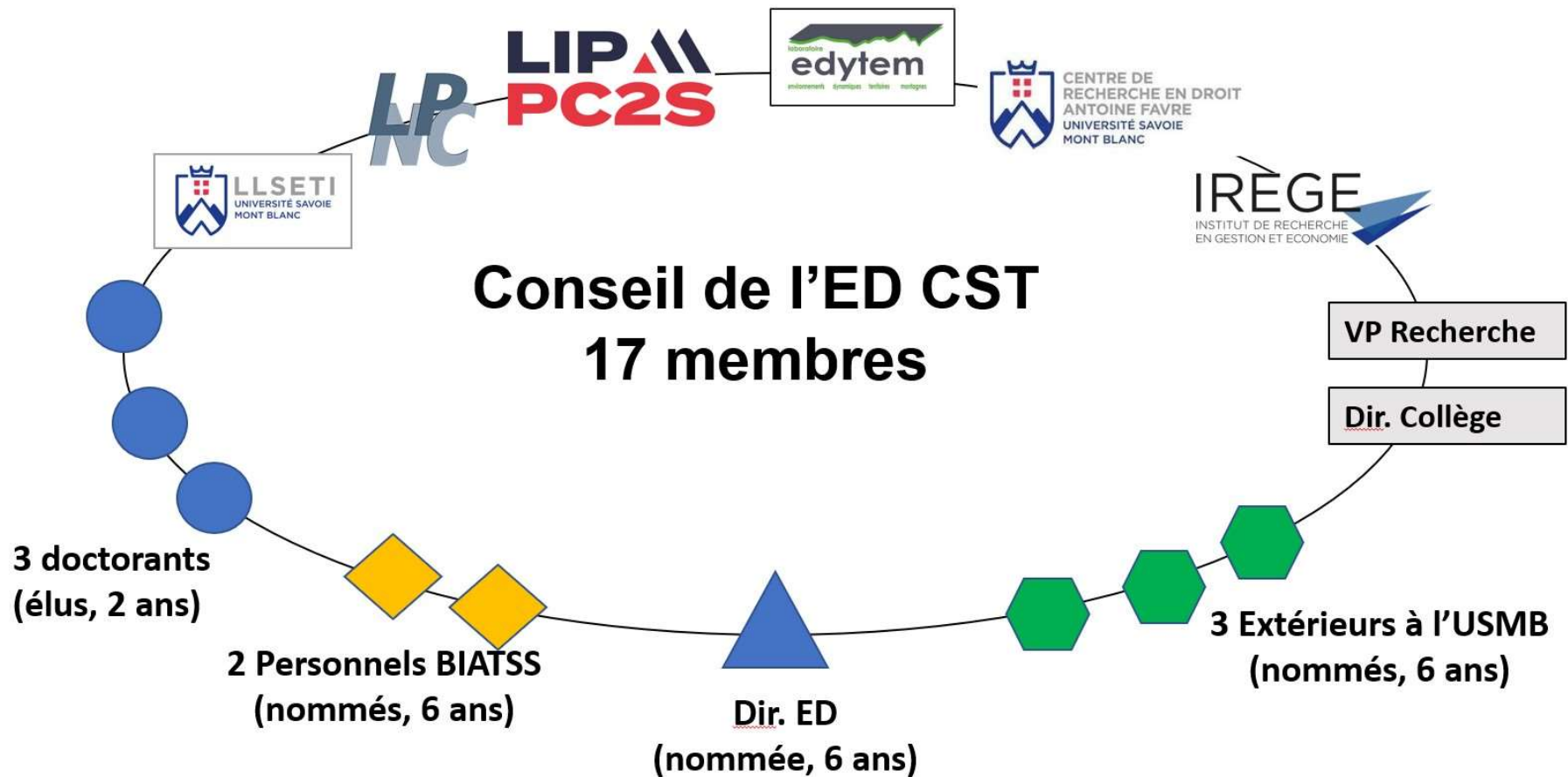

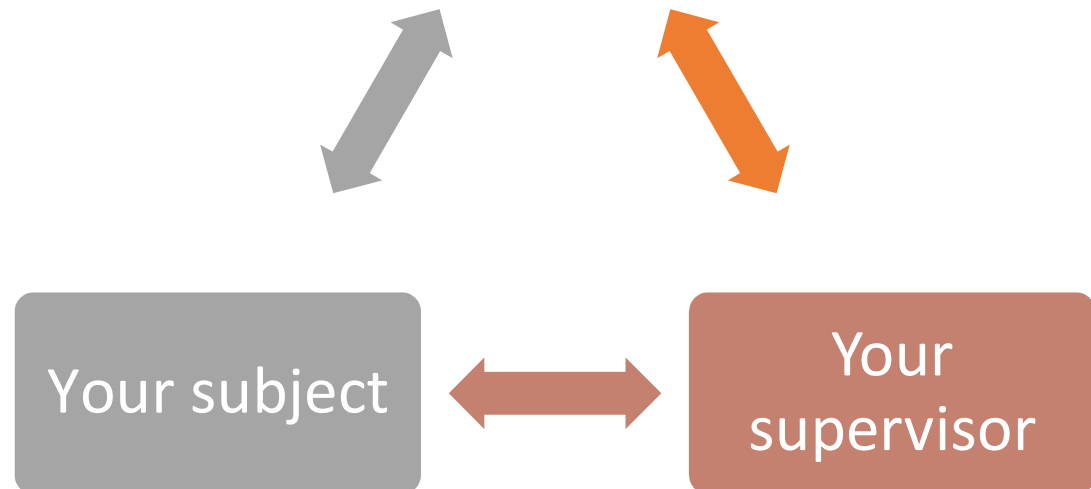

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Doctoral training

To obtain a doctorate, you must

- Successfully defend a doctoral thesis
- Validate training hours from your doctoral school (ED) and doctoral college (CED)



I'm doing...

- a **full-time thesis**: 120 hours of training to be validated
- a **part-time thesis** (salaried activity), a **CIFRE** thesis, a thesis at **GEM**: 50 hours of training to be validated

2 compulsory block seminars: to be chosen from 8 offered by the ED.

What is a block seminar?

- A series of lectures given by researchers over the course of a week.
- A week devoted to a specific theme, each day with the viewpoint of a different researcher and discipline.
- If I register for a block seminar, I must attend the whole course.
- There is no assessment. To be validated, you have to participate actively (motivation, active role during the block seminar).

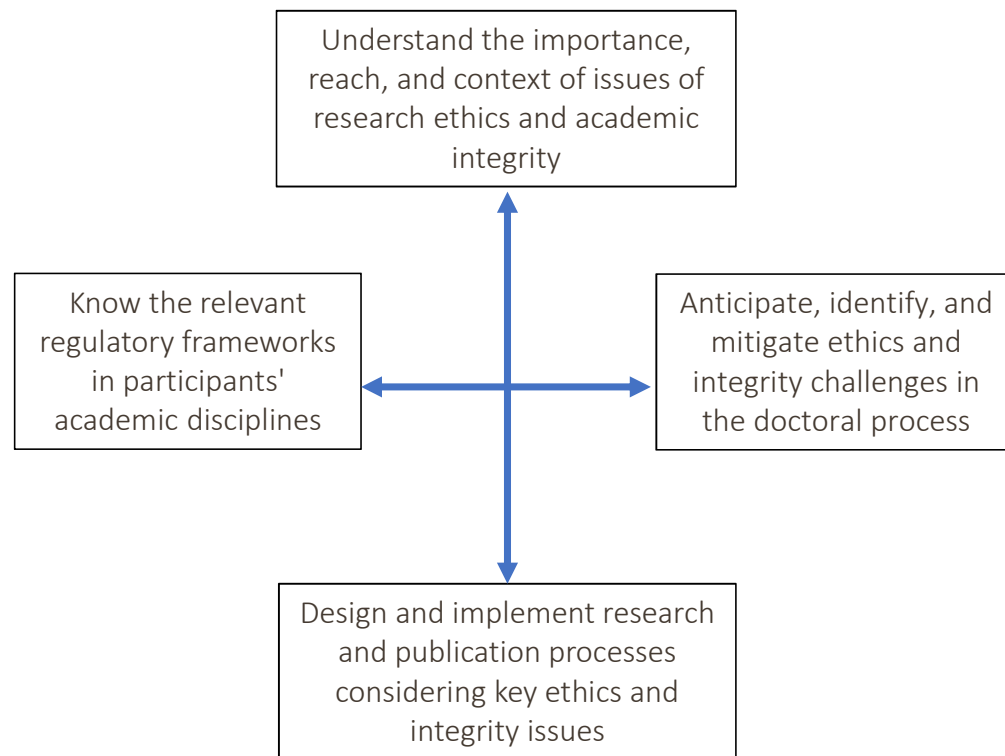
