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HOW AND WHEN CAN I APPLY?



Thank you very much for your interest in our Master's programme. You will find below answers to some of the questions you might have.

How and when can I apply?

Here is information regarding the 2022/2023 application campaign. The deadlines depend on your country of citizenship:

1. if you come from a country in the list below, you have to apply through this <u>website</u>. The application deadline depends on the country you come from and is available through the CampusFrance website dedicated to your country.

Here is the list of the countries concerned by this process:

What documents do you need to apply?

The following documents will be required for your application, whichever the process:

- a copy of your "baccalaureat" degree or equivalent degree corresponding to the end of secondary education, with its academic grade transcript
- the copies of your degrees with the corresponding academic grade transcripts and your rankings
- a description of the programmes you were enrolled in, up to now
- a resume
- a cover letter explaining your motivation for our programme and your professional project
- a copy of your identity card or passport
- language certificates and work certificates if any,
- any document you think useful for the evaluation of your application, such as a portfolio describing your achievements/projects completed to date if you apply through the first process described above.

Which level in English is required?

A good level in English is highly recommended since the classes of the programme are given in English and most of the master students are non-French-speaking people.

What are the tuition fees?

The tuition fees will amount to approximately $243 \in$ for the academic year 2022/2023. All students are also asked to pay what is called "CVEC" which stands for "<u>Contribution Vie</u> <u>Etudiante et Campus</u>", the amount of which was $92 \in$ in 2021/2022. Each student will have to pay approximately $335 \in$ /year to enroll in the programme.

When does the programme start?

The programme will start September 13, 2022

What is the content of the Master's programme?

The lectures and tutorials of our Master's programme are given in English. The programme consists in 4 semesters (30 ECTS/semester). 3 of them are based on blended learning to allow the customization of your study path (classroom learning, self-study through e-learning and project-based learning). The last semester is devoted to an internship (minimum 16 weeks).

Crous housing application

Thank you for completing and returning the file with supporting documents (page 1 of the attached file) before **June 17, 2022**, deadline, in ONE SINGLE shipment by return mail at <u>logement.chambery@crous-grenoble.fr</u>

Attention! Any incomplete file will not be studied. An assignment commission, composed of representatives from CLOUS and the University of Savoie will meet in mid-July to study the applications. At the end of the commission, the decision will be notified to you by email, as soon as possible.

You will find information about accommodation in **Bourget-du-Lac Campus** in this webpage.

Pay attention to the deadlines if you want to apply for housing in a <u>Crous student residence</u> (rather cheap housing managed by a French public institution for students). To increase your chance to get such a housing, it is recommended to apply as soon as possible, without waiting for the result of your application for the master's programme.

SOLAR ACADEMY EXCELLENCE SCOLARSHIP



Condition: On the basis of the quality of your academic background

Amount:

- Master 1: 4000 € (four thousand euros) for the academic year 2022/2023.
- Master 2: 2000€ (Two thousand euros) for the academic year 2022/2023.

In practice, you will receive the scholarship in two parts: one per semester. For the autumn semester, the amount of $2000 \in$ will be transferred in November. And in one part for the Master 2 ($2000 \in$ in November).

Conditions apply:

- You must be regularly enrolled at our university,
- You must follow all teaching activities and participate in the life of the Solar Academy, e.g. by helping to organize seminars, attending conferences, etc.

You will be asked to sign the excellence scholarship agreement, where these conditions will be specified.

Please note that in spring 2023, it'll be possible to apply for the M2 scholarship for the year 2023-2024 - the award will depend on your academic performance at our university.
