

WHAT IS IT?

This programme is a **training course of 200 hrs or 45 hrs**, based on French language learning covering all 6 levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFRL). Open to any person considered as a refugee or asylum seeker willing to acquire competences in French language, it will make you discover the French language and culture, but also, for intermediate and advanced levels, prepare for French university studies, by combining command of the language and progressive disciplinary immersion. Several rhythms are available: an intensive **programme of 20hrs per week** or a more **extensive one of only 4hrs per week**.


QUI PEUT S'INSCRIRE ?

HOW DO I KNOW WHICH LEVEL I SHOULD TAKE?



The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFRL) includes 6 levels:

- ▶ If you have no knowledge of French language at all, you will be automatically registered in the A1 level.
- ▶ If you have already some knowledge of French language and if you have a diploma or certification (DELF-DALF or TCF) to attest your level, you will be registered in the corresponding level (for example, if you have a DELF-B1 certification, you will attend group B2)
- ▶ If you have some knowledge of the French language, but you do not know exactly what your real level is, you will make a level test upon your arrival at the USMB and you will be registered in the corresponding level.

Attention: Groups will be open, subject to a minimum number of participants.

HOW TO REGISTER?

Fill in our online registration form. After a careful examination of your application, you will receive specific instructions to be officially registered. This registration will be definitely confirmed after payment of the registration fees to the university.

PRICE

Price of the training course (valid for the academic year 2018/2019):

45 hrs training course: 225 € / session

200 hrs training course: 900 € / session

INCLUDED:

- ▶ 45 or 200 hours of intensive French language training courses depending on the chosen programme;
- Access to cultural and sport activities organized by USMB for its international students (most activities are free of charge);
- Access to the different university services: university library and restaurants, preventive medicine, etc.

NOT INCLUDED:

- Payment of the Contribution Vie Etudiante (90€)
- Insurance covering liability (about 15€/year)
- Accommodation, food and any other personal expenses.



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
