Job opportunities

Excellent possibilities of graduates' career can be demonstrated by the fact that the joint master program will be carried out in the universities of two different countries and this will give students the opportunity to gain more diverse and multicultural experience, get more knowledge and skills, improve professional foreign language skills, gain international work experience and develop the ability to work in an open world.

Course content

First year of studies is held at Mykolas Romanis University, second year at Université Savoie Mont Blanc. Graduates of this programme will be awarded with SECOND YEAR (examples of courses) two diplomas.

- Applicants enrolled in the joint European and International Business Law master degree program must meet the following criteria:
 - have a university bachelor degree (or its equivalent) in law:
 - have a solid knowledge of English language (no less than the B2 level).
