

GOVID-19: How to get your "health pass"?



The "health pass" consists of the digital (via the TousAntiCovid application) or paper presentation of one of the following three health proofs:

- Vaccination, provided that people have a complete vaccination schedule and the necessary time after the final injection;
- Evidence of a negative test less than 72 hours old;
- The result of a positive RT-PCR or antigenic test demonstrating recovery of Covid-19, at least 11 days old and less than 6 months old

In France, the health pass will be useful for a wide range of activities (e.g. using public transport, taking part in a cultural activity, going to a restaurant, etc.).





You are not yet vaccinated:

You have the possibility to be vaccinated in France, including on the USMB campuses. Vaccination rooms will be set up from 13 to 15 September on the Bourget-du-Lac and Annecy campuses, and the following week on the Jacob-Bellecombette campus. It is free of charge. Registration will be done on the "Doctolib" website (link to come, watch your emails!). **(......**

You have already received a first dose in your home country:



f you have received a first dose of any of the following vaccines:

- Pfizer-BioNTech
- Moderna
- AstraZeneca / Oxford

You can make an appointment with the vaccination centre, which will give you a second dose of a vaccine authorised in France and you will then receive your vaccination certificate.



If you have received a first dose of another vaccine, such as:

- Institut Gamaleya / Spoutnik
- CanSino
- Anhui Zhifei
- Bharat Biotech
- Sinopharm
- Sinovac

You will need to make an appointment with the vaccination centre to **repeat a full vaccination** schedule as authorised in France.

You have been fully vaccinated in your country of origin:



If you have had this vaccination in a European country, you probably have a QR code that you can scan in the TousAntiCovid application and which will serve as your health pass throughout your stay.



If you are not from Europe and do not have a QR code, you are in one of two situations:

1) you have completed a full vaccination schedule with **one of the** following vaccines:

- Pfizer-BioNTech
- AstraZeneca / Oxford
- Johnson & Johnson

You can have your <u>vaccination certificate converted to obtain the</u> <u>health pass</u> valid in France. More information here:

2) you have completed a full vaccination schedule with another vaccine, including:

- Institut Gamaleya / Spoutnik
- Anhui Zhifei
- Bharat Biotech

You will need to make an appointment with the vaccination centre to **restart a full vaccination schedule** as authorised in France.

3) you have completed a full vaccination schedule with either Sinopharm or Sinovac:

You will have to make an appointment with the vaccination center to obtain another single dose of an ARNm vaccine.
