Title : UVT Green Week – Blue Economy in a European Context			

Short description:

The event „UVT Green Week – Blue Economy in a European Context” is organised by the West University of Timișoara and takes place in October-November 2022. This year’s edition is the 5th of the annual event, that has been previously selected as EU Green Week 2021 - Partner event.

The central theme of this autumn edition is dedicated to blue economy, considering that the West University of Timișoara has developed a working group dedicated to the integration of the European Green Deal considerations with respect to blue economy, in co-creation with regional and national partners, as well as with partners from European University Alliances.

The event also includes a **Blended Intensive Learning Programme (BIP)** dedicated to the **UNITA – Universitas Montium** community. The BIP takes place between 17th of October – 11th of May 2022 and is organised based on an open innovation model, involving all stakeholders representative for the quadruple helix model.

The virtual component will include virtual plenary sessions on blue economy topics + ideathon sessions, benefitting from mentorship with representatives of all stakeholder categories included in the quadruple helix innovation model.

Physical activity will include plenary sessions, hackathon sessions for the development of concrete solutions aimed at enhancing the European dimension of blue economy for ideas best awarded and jury selected after the virtual ideathon. Physical activity will also include study visits on premises of good practice examples of blue economy projects/ initiatives/ organisations/ facilities.
