**WHAT IS IT ABOUT?**

This programme consists of **intensive French language training** covering the 6 levels of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) combined with a programme of cultural and sporting activities allowing learners to discover the **Savoie Mont Blanc region**.

Open to anyone wishing to acquire French language skills, it aims to introduce students to the French language and culture but also, for intermediate to advanced levels, to prepare them for French university studies by combining language practice and progressive disciplinary immersion.



**WHO CAN REGISTER?**

Anyone over 18 with or without prior knowledge of French as a foreign language.



**WHEN?**

The programme runs **from Tuesday 30 May to Thursday 13 July 2023** inclusive.



**HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?**

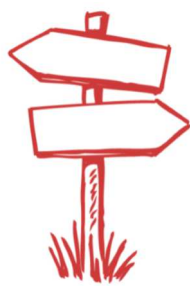
**Summer programme fee** (valid for the year 2023):  
**1'800€**

This fee includes:

- ▶ **90 hours of intensive French language courses;**
- ▶ **Accommodation** in a university residence in Chambéry (single rooms);
- ▶ Access to **cultural and sports activities** organised by the USMB for its international students;

This fee does not include (non-exhaustive list):

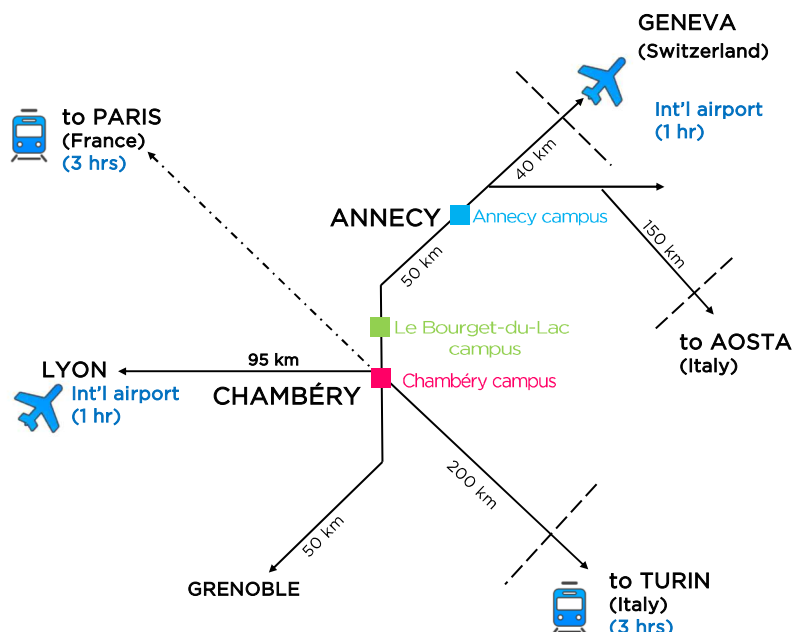
- ▶ International and national transports from the place of residence to Chambéry;
- ▶ Meals;
- ▶ Personal insurance to be taken out for travel, health and liability;
- ▶ Any other personal expenses.

In Chambéry (Jacob-Bellecombette campus) at the French language centre of the Université Savoie Mont Blanc: ACCENTS.



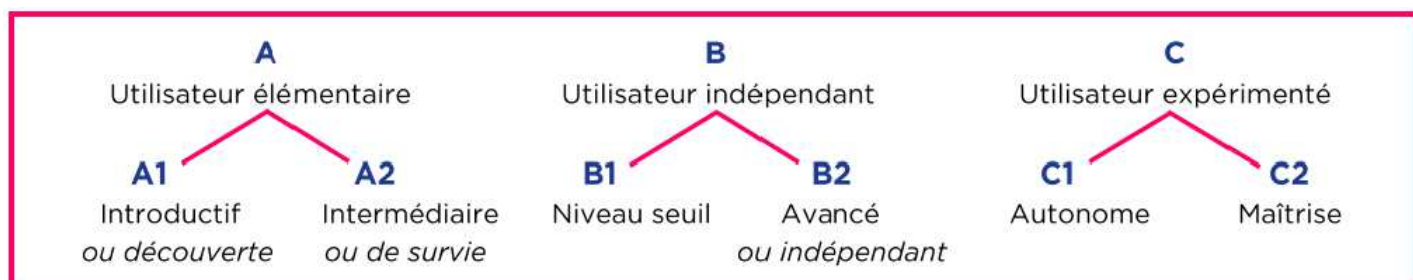
## WHY CHOOSE THE UNIVERSITÉ SAVOIE MONT BLANC ?

- ▶ Learning in **small groups**: 12 students on average;
- ▶ The USMB = a structure benefiting from the " **Label Qualité FLE** " ;
- ▶ A general organisation which leaves room for **cultural and sporting activities**;
  - ▶ A wide range of activities for **international students**;
- ▶ An **exceptional environment**: the city of Chambéry was recently elected by the magazine *l'Étudiant* as the number one medium-sized French city where it is good to study.



## WHAT LEVEL SHOULD YOU REGISTER FOR?

The Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) has 6 levels:



- ▶ If you have no knowledge of the French language, you will automatically be placed in level A1.
- ▶ If you already have some knowledge of the French language and your level has already been attested by a diploma or a certification such as the DELF-DALF or the TCF, you will be placed in the corresponding level (for example, if you have the DELF B1, you will be placed in the B2 group)
- ▶ If you already have some knowledge of the French language but you do not really know what your level is, you will take a placement test when you arrive at the USMB and will be placed in the corresponding level.

*Please note: the level groups will be open subject to a minimum number of participants.*



## HOW TO REGISTER?

Fill in an **online application form**. After analysis of your application, you will receive specific instructions for your final registration. *Your registration will only be validated after payment of the university registration fee.*
