Short description: The course analyzes successful case studies in actions on heritage that preserve and build European identity. The course addresses issues such as : Intangible heritage and artistic practices in the rural world and their role as activation elements of landscapes in decline ; Cultural landscapes and minor villages, ancient sites and rural domestic : coincidence and opportunity ; Built heritage, cartographies of memory ; Architectural interventions, keys for the recovery of memory as a hallmark of the new interventions in the rural nuclei of the mountain areas. The course includes on site visits to cases of success in the area of aragonese Pyrenees.
