# Title of BIP: "Method of learning styles for primary, secondary and higher education (REAPSES)"

### **General information**

## **Objectives and Description:**

Method of learning styles, REAPSES (Corners of Learning Styles for Primary, Secondary and Higher Studies) consists of working the themes or some topics that we have in our subject taking into account the Learning Styles presented by our students (active, reflective, pragmatic and theoretical) we can also use different learning styles to create groups through corners in the classroom and thus establish challenging activities.

# Objectives:

- Provide students with greater knowledge of their abilities and skills through the corners of learning styles.
- Provide teachers with a better understanding of their teaching style.

Contact partner universities of the European Union to work with the REAPSES method, and thus reach an agreement to carry out a joint work among universities that involves the transmission and sharing of knowledge from each specialty.

Students from universities in the European Union will make their mobility to know the work done in the subject given by the teacher at the University of Zaragoza and will present the joint material prepared in the online phase.

#### No of ECTS issued:

4 ECTS

The award of 4 ECTS credits is conditional on participation in the distance learning course and the intensive week, and on obtaining a final average equal to or higher than 5/10.

The evaluation system combines an online component, represented by the delivery of the final work (which accounts for 100% of the total value), and a classroom component that evaluates both class attendance (60%) and participation in the proposed activities (40%). The final grade is obtained by calculating the weighted average of both parts.
